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Cloud Cover Tracker

Split the sky into eighths and log how many of each eighth is filled with cloud

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Rainfall Tracker

Use a small jug that has measurements in Millemetres and log how many fill the jug daily

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Wind Speed Tracker
Use the Beaufort windspeed scale to measure how windy it is daily
